#### **BIOGRAPHY**

I was born in Berlin Germany and lived there for 28 years when I migrated to Australia in 1972.

Although having been interested in painting and drawing since teenage years, I did not pursue my passion until 1973, when experimenting and trying to copy paintings from known artists. I was in particular interested in Vincent Van Gogh and his luminous works. Believing that my dabbling with paints and brushes had some potential, I attended several private art groups, as well as the Melbourne School of Arts, Elsternwick, Victoria, for approximately two years. Thereafter, I joined the Victorian Artists' Society, National Gallery of Victoria and Contemporary Artists' Society, where I gained more knowledge about art in general, which contributed to my understanding of analysing paintings, composition and technique. I participated in various workshops for life drawing and painting, but also found pleasure in 'en plein air' painting with groups conducted by John Yule (dec).

In 1998 I completed a Bachelor of Arts (Fine Art) degree and continued to complete my Masters in Arts (Fine Art) in 2000 at RMIT University.

Through my studies I developed a great interest in hard-edged pattern and design. I was and still am inspired by the Artists Piet Mondrian, Igor Malevich, Ellsworth Kelly and Frank Stella, also Gerhard Richter and Dale Frank, to name a few. I am currently experimenting with different techniques and styles. My works are intuitive and conceptional, however, the language of colour is mainly evident in my paintings.

My current exhibition titled *Sayings and Quotations* – visually interpreted in the format of posters – is a colourful mixture of figurative, abstract and geometric paintings. Some are easily read and understood; others require imagination. Each painting adopts either a saying or quotation, hidden within the title or blurb adopted from what has been seen, heard or popular culture.
