Artist Statement

'Through the Night Sky' is my response to a 'happening' in deep space – maybe an exploding star, maybe a supernova – I remember only the eye-catching photograph that inspired this work. I imposed its central pattern onto my version of the night sky to emphasise the depth and breadth of space.

'Regeneration' followed the devastating bushfires that decimated much of the Grampians in early 2006. It was woven as one of a regional artist response to the fire and exhibited as part of a post-bushfire exhibition, 'Beyond the Smoke', at Dunkeld, Balmoral and Halls Gap.
